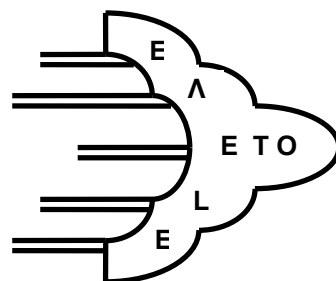

## 6<sup>th</sup> Conference “Hellenic Language and Terminology”

1-3 November 2007, Athens, GREECE

### Call for papers

The Hellenic Society for Terminology (ELETO) in cooperation with the University of Cyprus, the University of Athens (UOA), the Aristotelian University of Thessaloniki (AUTH), the University of Patras, the National Technical University of Athens (NTUA), the French Institute of Athens (IFA), the Technical Chamber of Greece (TCG), the Institute for Language and Speech Processing (ILSP), and the Organization for the Internationalization of the Hellenic language organize the **6<sup>th</sup> Conference “Hellenic Language and Terminology”**. The conference will be held in **Athens, Greece, on 1-3 November 2007**.

The 6<sup>th</sup> Conference is dedicated to **Vasilis A. Filopoulos**, president of ELETO and chairman of the organizing committees of all five former conferences, who recently passed away.

The aim of the Conference is to present the situation of the Hellenic language and terminology under current national and international conditions, from the viewpoint of both terminological research and applications, and to coordinate the terminological work in Greece and Cyprus.

#### Themes of the Conference:

1. Diachronic aspects of terminology
2. Linguistic-ontological principles of terminology (terminology and knowledge, designating principles and methods, etc.)
3. Didactics and terminology
4. Terminology in specific subject fields – Lexicographical and terminographical studies
5. Terminological resources (special and multilingual dictionaries, term selections, special corpora)
6. Standardization of terminology (internationalization of concepts, and interlingual standardization and equivalence of terms, terminology proposals)
7. New technologies and terminology
8. Terminology and translation
9. Activities of organizations and bodies for terminology

Official languages of the Conference will be Greek, English and French

Submission of abstracts by	<b>5 March 2007</b>
Approval of abstracts by	<b>5 April 2007</b>
Submission of full papers by	<b>15 June 2007</b>

#### Abstracts and papers:

Participants wishing to present a paper at the Conference are invited to submit an **abstract**. The abstract should be written in one of the official languages of the Conference and should neither be less than **120** words nor exceed **200** words. The following items must appear on the page of the abstract:

- a) title, place and dates of the Conference: **6<sup>th</sup> Conference “Hellenic Language and Terminology”, Athens, Greece, 1-3 November 2007**
- b) title of the paper
- c) name, profession, full address, tel. no / fax no and e-mail address of the author(s) and
- d) which of the themes above the paper comes under.

The abstract should be drafted in electronic form (MS WORD **doc** format) and sent by e-mail, as an **attached file**, to: [valeonti@otenet.gr](mailto:valeonti@otenet.gr).

Following the examination of the abstracts by the Scientific Committee of the Conference, the authors of the selected papers will receive the necessary information for the preparation of the full texts of their papers.
