Dr. Irine Darchia is Associate Professor in Classical Philology, Deputy Head of the Institute of Classical, Byzantine and Modern Greek Studies and Head of the Quality Assurance Service of the Ivane Javakhishvili Tbilisi State University. She defended her doctoral thesis on *Plato's Phaedo (Literature, Philosophy, Mythology, Mysticism)* in 1998 and her post-doctoral thesis (Habilitation) on *Colour Phenomenon in Greek Tragedy* in 2005.

She studied Modern Greek Language at the National and Kapodistrian University of Athens and in the Summer School of Kalymnos organized by the Committee of International and Cultural Exchange of Athens-Kalymnos.

She systematically participates in international conferences, seminars, workshops, trainings, projects concerning classical and modern Greek studies, educational issues and the Bologna Process (Georgia, Greece, Italy, Germany, Austria, Bulgaria, Russia, USA).

She is teaching at the Departments of Classical, Byzantine and Modern Greek Studies and she was visiting professor at the Freie University of Berlin (Germany) and the University of Pisa (Italy).

She speaks six foreign languages (Modern Greek, English, Russian, Italian, Ancient Greek, Latin), has published four books (two monographs, handbook, dictionary) and more than twenty articles on ancient Greek philosophy, tragedy, colour perception and the history of Greek language.
