Marita Kristiansen is associate professor of English linguistics at the Norwegian School of Economics (NHH) in Bergen where she teaches business English and terminology & specialised communication. She also coordinates the Nordic *Termdist* network which offers an online master course in terminology.

Her current research interests include domain dynamics, neology studies, term formation and the use of online corpora to detect new Norwegian terminology. In addition, she has in recent years worked on language planning and policy issues both as a former member of the Norwegian language council's terminology advisory board and locally at her home institution in establishing language policies for NHH. Presently she is a member of the Norwegian Association of Higher Education Institutions' term group and has recently also participated in a Nordic network which focuses on domain loss vs. the internationalisation of Nordic higher education institutions (<http://nordiskparallelsprogsnet.blogs.ku.dk/>).

She has also for several years worked with colleagues at NHH on developing a national terminology portal as well as language technology resources for terminology, including a termbase for economic-administrative domains. She has published papers in international journals such as *Terminology*, *Studies in Corpus Linguistics*, *Neologica* and *Terminology Science and Research: Journal of the International Institute of Terminology Research*.
