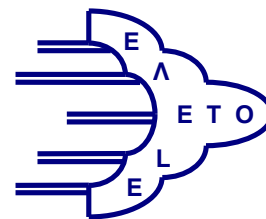


SENSOTERM:

Termbase of Sensory Analysis

Resulting from the work of cooperation between GESY of ELETO and Consumer and Sensory Lab of the University of the Aegean

Short history of the Termbase SENSOTERM

The Termbase SENSOTERM is quadrilingual (*Greek, English, French and German terms*) and was created, in 2023, by **Kostas Valeontis**, president of the Hellenic Society for Terminology (ELETO) and chairman of ELETO's Scientific Board (GESY) in order to import all the English, Greek, French and German equivalent terms of the Alphabetical English-Greek-French-German glossary of terms of Sensory Analysis (286 entries), which was prepared by **Kostas Valeontis**, **George Tsiamas** and **Malamatenia Panagiotou**, based on the sources: ISO 5492:2008 Sensory analysis – Vocabulary και English-Greek-Glossary of terms and concept definitions of Sensory Analysis. The latter has been prepared by GESY in cooperation with the Consumer and Sensory Lab of the University of the Aegean.

The development, operation, maintenance and feeding of SENSOTERM is performed by its creator himself, who has also the responsibility for the content of ELETO's website. Searching via the Termbank of the website has been ensured by **Nikos Valeontis**, the IT administrator of the website. Thus, free accessing and searching the Termbase SENSOTERM is available on the Internet, via ELETO's website.

The field structure of the Termbase SENSOTERM comprises the following basic fields (which, in each entry, correspond to a single concept):

BASIC FIELDS OF SENSOTERM

- English term
- English abbreviation
- Greek term
- Greek abbreviation
- French term
- French abbreviation
- German term
- German abbreviation
- Foreign language reference source
- Greek language reference source
- Stage of processing

Today, the termbase SENSOTERM contains 286 terminological entries of sensory analysis.
