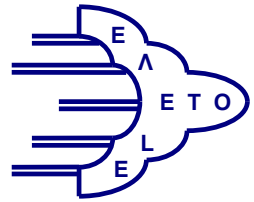

Technical Committee ELOT/TC 21 Terminology – Language resources

After the foundation of the Hellenic Organization for Standardization (ELOT), in 1978, the Technical Committee ELOT/TC 21 *Terminology – Language resources* (initial name: *Technical Terminology*) was established, at the initiative of the Technical Chamber of Greece (TEE), ever since having undertaken the committee's technical and secretarial support. The terms of reference of ELOT/TC 21 is to be the national mirror committee to the international Technical Committee ISO/TC 37 *Language and terminology*. ELOT/TC 21 attends ISO/TC 37's work and contributes with constructive comments to the International Standards prepared by the latter.

ELOT/TC 21 is a founding Collective Member of the Hellenic Society for Terminology (ELETO), whose delegates actively participate in the work of the committee.

To date, ELOT/TC 21 has prepared 11 Hellenic Standards, corresponding to International Standards of ISO/TC 37; as well as one primarily Greek standard: ELOT 1455:2017 *Greek initialisms and acronyms formation*. In 1981–1982, ELOT/TC 21 prepared and published the Hellenic Standards ELOT 402 and ELOT 561 corresponding to ISO 704 and ISO 1087 respectively, the basic standards of terminology principles and methods. The content of these standards was analysed in a special publication of ELOT: [Analysis of basic principles of technical terminology](#), which also includes the first glossaries (Greek-English, English-Greek) of terminology terms. Recently, these standards have been republished as Hellenic Standards ELOT 402:2010 and ELOT 561-1:2006, with special contribution from ELETO.

The terminology terms of the standards prepared by ELOT/TC 21 are being collected, by the ELETO's delegate in the committee, Kostas Valeontis, into the termbase TERMTERM, today containing 3.147 entries.
