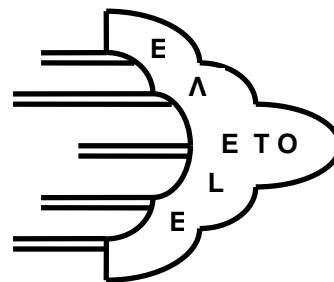

Announcement

4th Conference “Hellenic Language and Terminology”

The Hellenic Society for Terminology (ELETO) in cooperation with the University of Athens (UOA), the University of Thessaloniki (AUTH), the University of Patras, the Ionian University, the National Technical University of Athens (NTUA), the French Institute of Athens (IFA), the Hellenic Organization for Standardization (ELOT), the Institute for Language and Speech Processing (ILSP), the Organization for the Internationalization of the Hellenic language and the Panhellenic Association of Professional Translators organize the 4th Conference for the “Hellenic Language and Terminology”.

The aim of the Conference is to present the current situation of the Hellenic Terminology in the multilingual environment of the European Union in relation with the requirements of the Information Society.

The subjects of the Conference are the following:

1. Historical aspects
2. Linguistic-Ontological principles of Terminology focused on the Hellenic Terminology (principles and methods for designation, etc.)
3. Terminological resources (special and multilingual dictionaries, term selections, special corpora).
4. Standardization of Terminology (internationalization of concepts, and interlingual standardization and equivalence of terms).
5. New technologies and Terminology.
6. Terminology in Translation.
7. Activities of organizations and bodies for Terminology.

The Conference is open to everyone interested in the Hellenic language and terminology. The official languages of the Conference will be Greek, English and French.

The Conference will be held in **Athens** on **October 30, 31,** and **November 1, 2003.**

Participants wishing to present a paper at the Conference are invited to submit an **abstract**. The abstract should be written in one of the official languages of the Conference and should not exceed 150 words.

The following items must appear on the page of the abstract:

- a) The title, place and time of the Conference: **4rd Conference “Hellenic Language and Terminology”, Athens, Greece, October 30, 31, and November 1, 2003**
- b) The title of the paper
- c) The name, profession, full address, tel no/fax no and e-mail of the author(s).

The abstract should be delivered up to **March 15, 2003** either by e-mail (mail to: valeonti@otenet.gr) as an attached file in **doc** format (MS WORD 97 or WORD 2000), or by mail as a hard copy and a floppy disk, to the address:
