

7th Conference “Hellenic Language and Terminology”

22-24 October, 2009 – Athens, GREECE

Call for papers

The Hellenic Society for Terminology (ELETO) in cooperation with the University of Athens (UOA), the Athens University of Economics and Business (AUEB), the Aristotle University of Thessaloniki (AUTH), the University of Patras, the National Technical University of Athens (NTUA), the University of Cyprus, the Technical Chamber of Greece (TCG), the Institute for Language and Speech Processing (ILSP), the Hellenic Organization for Standardization (ELOT), and the Organization for the Promotion of the Hellenic Language organize the 7th Conference “Hellenic Language and Terminology”. The conference will be held in Athens, Greece, on 22-24 October 2009.

The 7th Conference is dedicated to **Aristotle**, the father of Ontology and Logic, which are at the basis of the contemporary science of Terminology.

The aim of the Conference is to present the current situation of the Greek language from a terminological point of view, as well as methods, practices and tools of Terminology science, and their application in the Greek language environment – monolingual and/or interlingual –, with a view to promote terminological research and contribute to the present-day terminological enrichment of the Greek language.

Themes of the Conference:

1. Linguistic-ontological principles of terminology (terminology and knowledge, naming principles and methods, etc.)
2. Didactics and terminology
3. Terminology in specific subject fields – Lexicographical and terminographical studies – Synchronic and diachronic aspects
4. Terminological resources (special monolingual or multilingual dictionaries, term collections, special corpora) – New technologies and terminology
5. Standardization of terminology (internationalization of concepts, and interlingual standardization and equivalence of terms, terminology proposals)
6. Terminology and translation
7. Dissemination and use of terms – Terminology policies and regulation
8. Activities of organizations and bodies for terminology

Languages:

Official languages of the Conference will be Greek, English and French.

Critical dates:

Submission of abstracts by	15 March 2009
Approval of abstracts by	10 April 2009
Submission of full papers by	15 June 2009

Abstracts and papers:

Participants wishing to present a paper at the Conference are invited to submit an **abstract**. The abstract should be written in one of the official languages of the Conference and should neither be less than **200** words nor exceed **300** words. The following items must appear on the page of the abstract:

- a) title, place and dates of the Conference: **7th Conference “Hellenic Language and Terminology”, Athens, Greece, October 22-24, 2009**
- b) title of the paper
- c) name, title/profession, full address, tel. no / fax no, and e-mail address of the author(s) and
- d) the themes (see above) the paper comes under.

The abstract should be drafted in electronic form (MS WORD **.doc** format) and sent by e-mail, as an **attached file**, to: valeonti@otenet.gr.

Following the examination of the abstracts by the Scientific Committee of the Conference, the authors of the selected papers will receive the necessary information for the preparation of the full texts of their papers.
