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Joseph Mariani is a Fellow researcher at CNRS. He was the director of [LIMSI](#), a French [CNRS](#) laboratory, from 1989 to 2000, and head of its "[Human-Machine Communication](#)" department. He then became Director of the "Information and Communication Technologies" department at the [French Ministry for Research](#) from 2001 to 2006. Since 2007, he is the director of the Institute for Multilingual and Multimedia Information ([IMMI](#)), a joint International Laboratory involving LIMSI-CNRS in France, the Karlsruhe Institute of Technology ([KIT](#)) and the Technical University of Aachen ([RWTH](#)) in Germany, which is part of the Integrated Management Team of the [Quaero](#) program .

He chaired the CNRS ICT Advisory Committee and was a member of the CNRS Engineering department Advisory Committee, Scientific Council and Ethics Committee ([COMETS](#)). He is now a member of the national Ethics committee for ICT ([CERNA](#)). Within his ministerial duties, he seated in the Board of Trustees of several French entities ([ANFr](#) , [IGN](#), [OST](#), [INRIA](#),...). He was recently a member of the Board of the [System@tic](#) Competitiveness Cluster, and of the Scientific Committees of the Telecommunication Engineering Schools ([Institut Télécom](#)) and of the National Institute for Research on Safety ([INRS](#)).

He served as convenor of the Coordinating Committee on Speech Databases and I/O Systems Assessment ([Cocosda](#)) and of the [AUF](#) Francophone Language Engineering Network (Francil), and as president of the European Speech Communication Association, now International Speech Communication Association ([ISCA](#)) and as president of the European Language Resources Association ([ELRA](#)).

He participated in many EC projects, and recently in [FLaReNet](#) (the Fostering Language Resources Network) and in [META-NET](#) (the Multilingual Europe Technology Alliance Network of Excellence), where he seats in the Executive Board.

An author of more than 600 publications and communications, he is in the Editorial Committees of the "[Language Resources and Evaluation](#)" and "[Speech Technology](#)" Journals, and of the "[Text, speech and language](#)" book series.
